



INTERACTIVE PDF (iPDF) - AN ALTERNATIVE TO LEVEL - 1 COURSES

An effective and powerful tool to enhance the training of L1 or fundamental blocs of learning.

In the early 90s, Adobe developed the PDF (Portable Document Format) tool to faciliate sharing of data over electronic mediums easily. It is a revolutionary step.

What makes PDF a great tool is its framework to store information in container blocs. A PDF document is laden with layers of containers in which different programs can be embedded.

Those engaged with eLearning of L&D (learning and development) services, especially the designers and developers, are aware that bloc designs/architecture helps creating custom IDs, styling, reusability, and to make the layout responsive.

As a result, the practice was adopted for today's HTML5 framework launched in 2014 on the recommendation of W3C (World Web Consortium). Thus, it can be said that a PDF document incorporates the specifications of WCAG (Web Content Accessibility Guidelines) as default.

So, can a PDF be used as an interactive learning tool?

WHAT IS AN

NTERACTIVE PDF?

An interactive PDF is a document that incorporates all kinds of rich media content such as, hyperlinks, audio and video files, images, GIF animations, clickable buttons, fillable forms and similar.

A static PDF document can be transformed into an interactive courseware, popularly called as iPDF depending on its content.

One can add/create different types of interactive elements to the iPDF like:

- menus
- popups
- tooltips
- click tabs
- dropdown
- type-in text boxes
- GIFs and animation
- branched navigations
- knowledge checks with generic feedback
- short demonstrative or To-Do videos
- podcasts or audio
- hyperlinks
- external resources

INTERACTIVE PDF

Restrict content optimization

Typically the architecture of iPDF stores contents inside containers, therefore, the algorithms of a search engines or the Learning Managment System (LMS) fails to recognise or track them.

Uses the obsolete Flash elements

Typically Flash application is used to create the interactive buttons, animations, quizlets in iPDF. In December 2020, Adobe scrapped the tool as a result all operating systems (whether of mobile or web) no more supports Flash elements or programs.

Syncing invalid

Typically, e-learning courses include audio narration synced with the animation timeline. Since, animations are built using the Flash tool it is not supported by most platforms.

User subscribe/register to Adobe or to a third-party tool in search of an application that could sync the animation to the audio narration. It's complicated, costly, and time-consuming process—impractical.

- a. Use <JavaScript> and Node.js to offer a hermetic environment to each information bloc.
- b. Use metatags, XML, and in-page links to make the containers identifiable and optimised to search engines and LMS.
- c. Use SARAS® Test and Assessment Engine instead of the Flash program for the quizzes and knowledge checks.
- d. Use the screen reader tool and add subtitles to the animations and video content to sync audio with the text.
- e. Convert the Flash-based animations into MPEG.

In addition, we ensure that appropriate instructional principles (Bloom, Gagne, or Merill) have been applied to the interactivities, content structuring, and assessment (offline or online).


